CHIRURGIE GENERALE

GARDER UN CHIEN AU REPOS

Assurez-vous de garder le chien à l'intérieur le plus possible, de limiter son activité physique, de surveiller la guérison de la plaie et d'administrer les médicaments prescrits. Il ne doit pas lécher sa plaie. Il est possible de garder le chien au repos en cage, en enclos ou dans une pièce sécuritaire.

GARDER UN CHAT AU REPOS

Il y a deux options pour garder un chat au repos complet. On peut lui aménager une grande cage de chien avec un griffoir, une litière, un lit, etc. Sinon, on le garde au repos dans une pièce où il ne pourra pas sauter.

MÉDICATION

Le plan de traitement varie selon l'opération. Habituellement, on parle d'administration de médication par voie orale. Il est possible que le vétérinaire prescrive un traitement qui calmera l'animal durant sa période de repos.

RECOMMANDATIONS

Retirez les jouets de l'animal et stimulez-le mentalement (bol interactif, canne sur tapis de léchage, etc.) En cas de rougeur, d'écoulements, et/ou d'enflure de la plaie, contactez Mission Mayday.

GENERAL SURGERY

PREPARATIONS

To ensure a worry-free surgical procedure, the pet must be fasted from food approximately 12 hours before the appointment. Make sure he always has fresh water available. Maintaining adequate hydration is crucial for your well-being.

DROP THE ANIMAL AT THE CLINIC

Allow approximately 15 to 30 minutes for the animal to arrive at the clinic. A brief pre-operative consultation will be carried out. Some clinics sometimes release families before carrying out the examination.

RECOVER THE ANIMAL

When the surgery is completed, you will receive updates by text message or call, in order to plan the pet's discharge. Generally, he is kept at the center 24 hours after the operation. For minor procedures, he can leave the hospital or clinic at the end of the day.

REMOVAL OF STITCHES

The stitches will need to be removed at the clinic after 10 to 14 days. You will need to provide your availability to Mission Mayday to make the appointment.

KEEPING A DOG AT REST

Be sure to keep the dog indoors as much as possible, limit physical activity, monitor wound healing, and administer prescribed medications. He must not lick his wound. It is possible to keep the dog resting in a cage, enclosure or in a secure room.

KEEPING A CAT AT REST

There are two options for keeping a cat on complete rest. You can set up a large dog cage with a scratching post, a litter box, a bed, etc. Otherwise, we keep him resting in a room where he cannot jump.

MEDICATION

The treatment plan varies depending on the operation. Usually, this is referred to as oral medication administration. The veterinarian may prescribe a treatment that will calm the animal during its rest period.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Remove toys from the animal and stimulate it mentally (interactive bowl, cane on licking mat, etc.) If there is redness, discharge, and/or swelling from the wound, contact Mission Mayday.
